Are you sure that you're you?

Do you know about Identity Theft? If criminals manage to get your personal information they can wreak havoc. They will get your details by going through your bins and finding letters or bills that you've thrown away, or call you and pretend to be from a legitimate organisation. They then use your

details to open bank accounts, apply for loans/credit cards/passports, or to order goods. Simple steps can help reduce your risk: for example shredding/destroying anything that you throw out that has personal details on them (I chew that part of the envelope or letter!). Additionally, if it's a phone

call, #TakeFive seconds and remember no one will ever ask you for PIN over the phone. Don't ignore it if you think you're a victim of this crime, contact your bank urgently, and head to www.actionfraud.police.uk for more information

Too busy to report it?

We're reminding people again that if they are a victim of crime, no matter the circumstances, the incident can be reported to police. A lot of people think they haven't got the time, or deem it unimportant, but your safety

and your lives are of paramount importance. Reporting **online** is a very quick and easy way to alert the police to a crime, which in turns shapes the way we police as we become aware of trends and

areas we need to patrol. To date, the following incidents can be reported: Crime, Road Traffic Incidents, Missing persons, ASB, Fraud, Lost/found

property or vehicles. It's very simple to use - just head to www.met.police.uk and clicking the **report** button

5 - Follow us on Twitter (if you haven't done already!) Spread the word so we can help others



Advice and Contacts

Broad Green Safer Neighbourhood Team work in partnership with many different organisations to try and resolve issues around our ward. Over the next couple of pages we've compiled a list of useful contacts for you should you

need them. For us, we've put a reminder for people of when you should call what number:
999: When a crime is occurring at the time, Someone is in immediate danger, or a risk of serious damage to property is imminent,

Suspect for crime is nearby, or a Traffic collision with injury or danger to other road users
101: A crime not currently in progress (for example a burglary or stolen car), To give information to police about crime in your area, General enquiries with the

police, or Contacting a specific officer or member of staff for an update
(We only remind people about this due to what has been seen on social media, people calling the emergency services for a DNA test in regards to a cheating partner, for example!)


