Literacy-

The children will continue to use exciting vocabulary, conjunctions, openers and a variety of punctuation in their writing. We are planning and writing stories, riddles, persuasive letters, information text about animals and making notes to remember ideas. We will also will be enjoying reading a variety of fiction and non fiction books. The children will also be writing across the curriculum. We will also be reinforcing their knowledge

Numeracy

We will continue to consolidate the children's knowledge of number facts and calculations. During this half term, we will be learning about fractions, problem solving, money, time and coordinates. Please take every opportunity to ask questions in real life situations, like when you are out shopping to help the children to develop their understanding of solving problems.

We will also be teaching aspects of ICT, music, RE and PSHE as the term progresses. Our planning is linked across the curriculum.

Animals

Art

This half term we will be looking at line and tone, this will be linked to our science and geography by looking at animals and art from around the world.

Science

In science, we will be learning about animals , including humans. The children will learn about the offspring of animals and how they develop into adults. They will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals for survival (water, food and air). We will also describe the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and hygiene.

Geography

In geography we will continue our learning about the continents and oceans of the world. You will help the children's understanding by looking at maps together and talking about the different continents and about any countries they have visited. They will also be learning about mapping skills, such as using coordinates and knowing what some symbols on maps mean.
